The Veterans section was in existence in 1980 as confirmed by the first captain being recorded in that year. The minimum age for membership at that time was 55 later changed to 60 as it is today. Membership was not automatic and was secured with a small annual fee. In 1990 Veterans became Seniors in line with the county and other clubs. Competitions were held on Wednesdays and later changed to Mondays for the 1991 season.

In the early days when there were fewer competitions, it was accepted that members turning up on non-competition days would find someone to play with. It was from such early beginnings that the roll up developed. It was probably as late as 1996 when the roll up was formalised with a draw for partners and those playing contributing £1 with all monies paid out in prizes, a process which continues to the present day. This was established on Mondays when there were no Cup or Trophy competitions and on Wednesdays and Fridays. A full programme of Monday competitions has since been established and the Wednesday and Friday roll up continues in much the same format as it was introduced.

A significant change came about at the senior's AGM on 30 October 2006 when the section agreed to the Executive Committee's suggestion that the section should be open to any member aged 60 and over without any additional seniors membership fee being levied. The Seniors were then charged with the organisation of Seniors' competitions on behalf of the club. The Senior's Captain was at that stage invited to join the Executive Committee and to receive the benefits with the office of an honorarium and a car park space.

As a result the section has grown in size with a large percentage of club members now eligible to play in Senior's competitions. As club administration support work grew, the Senior's were asked to contribute 20% of competition green fees in common with all other club competitions rather than the annual one off payment which hitherto had been made. The pro shop organises the Monday competitions with a nominated member of the committee acting as liaison with the competitors on the day.

It is from those early days of 1980 and before that the seniors have developed. The section continues to enjoy social and competitive golf and endeavours to set standards to which everyone can aspire.
